STARTER KIT & CARE GUIDE

DAILY CARE:

Feeding:

Feed every other day or 3 times per week. Crested gecko Diet (CGD) or 3-5 Crickets, super worms, discoid roaches, or BSF larvae. (if dusted with calcium powder use WITH D3)

Misting:

Ideally 2x daily. Morning and evening. Will be fine going a few days without misting on occasion.

MONTHLY CARE:

Clean all decorations as needed with water and vinegar or warm water with a dash of Dawn dish soap. Replace paper towel weekly or as needed.

Temperatures:

70°-75°F during the day, **67°-72°F** at night

No additional heat or basking light necessary unless you keep your house really cold.

Lighting:

Geckos do not need a light source or UVB. A simple LED is fine for viewing the gecko, and to help them be asleep during the day and active at night. Most cheap LED lights give off a little heat which is fine giving them a warmer feel near the "sun" and a cooler feel in the shade of the bottom of the tank.

FACTS:

- Crested Geckos live 8 to 12 years, although with proper care, gecko owners have been reporting longer life spans!
- These geckos can drop their tails, only once. This species cannot grow them back. Because of this, they are less likely to drop it unless seriously spooked or stressed.
- Crested geckos originate from new cambodia, and have been in the pet trade since 1994, but weren't widely available until 2014 and still gaining popularity.
- They don't have eye lids, and clean their eyes using their tongues.
